Further, you are requested to obtain information with regard to the individuals with criminal antecedents selected as candidates by the political parties, in the ensuing elections to the Assam Legislative Assembly, 2021, from the RO of your Election District in the Format CA (copy enclosed) and furnish the same to this department, for onward submission to the Election Commission of India by the last date of filing of nominations, as delineated in ECI letter No.: 3/4/2020/SDR – Vol.III dated 19 March 2020.


